

HOW TO SORT YOUR HOUSEHOLD WASTE



FOOD WASTE

For example:
Peelings and leftovers from vegetables and fruits. Leftovers from meat, fish and shellfish. Dead flowers, eggshells, candy, coffee grinds and teabags.

Use the paper bag intended for food waste.



PAPER PACKAGING

For example:
Milk and cream cartons, cereal boxes, egg cartons, laundry detergent packages, gift wrapping paper and paper bags.

Separate plastic lids from the cartons if possible.



PLASTIC PACKAGING

For example:
Ketchup bottles, soap bottles, plastic crisps and sweets bags, plastic lids, toothpaste tubes, plastic bags and styrofoam packaging.

No plastic products other than packaging.



NEWSPAPERS

For example:
Newspapers, magazines, catalogues, leaflets, brochures, writing paper and paperback books.

Spiral bindings and staples can be left.



COLOURED GLAS PACKAGING

For example:
Coloured glass bottles and jars/containers. The container should be empty. Sort lids and caps according to their material.

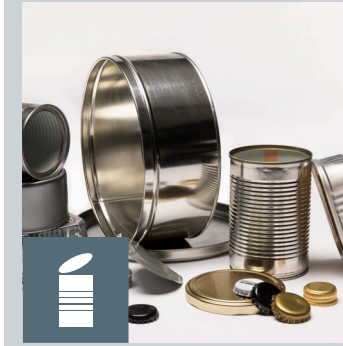
No glas products other than packaging.



CLEAR GLAS PACKAGING

For example:
Clear glass bottles and jars/containers. The container should be empty. Sort lids and caps according to their material.

No glas products other than packaging.



METAL PACKAGING

For example:
Metal lids and caps. Aluminium foil, tin cans/metal food containers and metal tubes. The packaging should be empty. Spray cans must be completely empty.

No metal products other than packaging.



RESIDUAL WASTE

For example:
Diapers, sanitary towels and tampons. Cat litter, vacuum cleaner bags, dish cloths and envelopes. Old shoes, small quantities of potting soil and post-it notes.

Put the residual waste in a bag that is securely tied.



ELECTRONICS

For example:
Small electronic waste such as light bulbs, batteries and chargers is either left at the recycling center, in your waste disposal room or electronics box.

Big electronic waste must be deposited at a recycling center.



HAZARDOUS WASTE

For example:
Paint, nail polish, detergent, pressure treated wood and spray cans that are not emptied. Hazardous waste must be deposited at a recycling center.

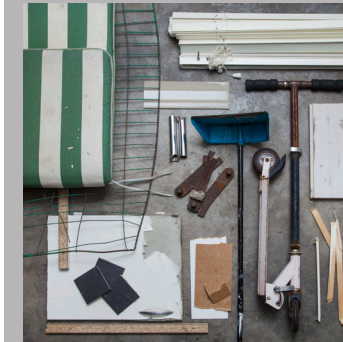
Medicines and injection needles must be taken to the drug store.



FABRIC

For example:
Sweaters, socks, bed linen and textile bags. Dispose reusable textiles and textile waste in collection boxes at the recycling station or center.

Clean and dry textiles. Wet or contaminated textiles? Recycling center.



BULKY WASTE

For example:
Cushions, pallets, padded furnitures, flower pots. Appliances, plaster and mattresses. Bulky waste can be disposed of at a recycling center.
